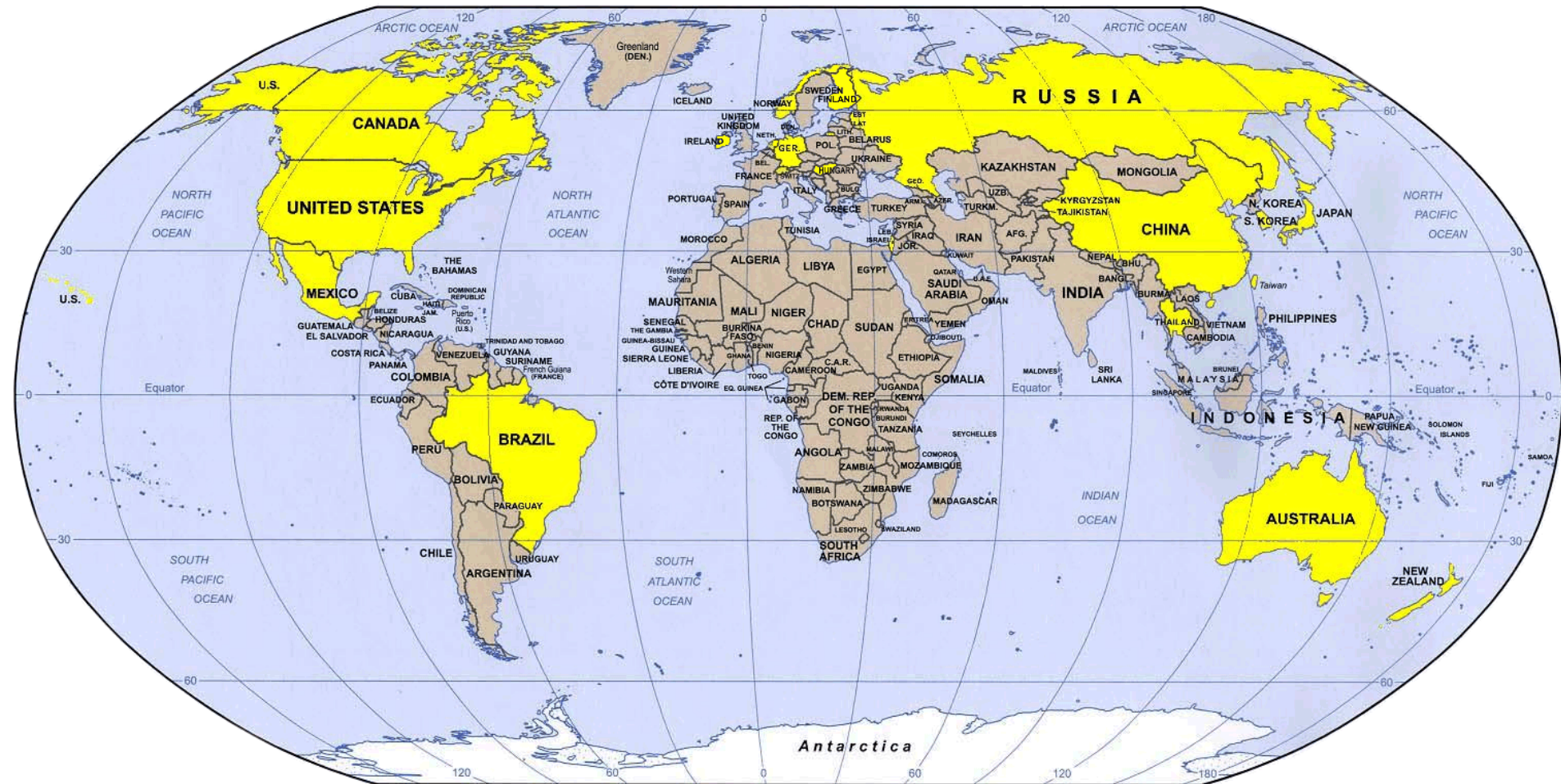


# WORLD FOOD DAY 'United Against Hunger'

These are the students at Hsa Mu Htaw School in Thailand. These children are from Burma and live in refugee camps. They have come to Thailand for safety and education.



The students that attend Hsa Mu Htaw are very poor, they live in houses like you can see here. The children do not have much food to eat at lunchtime. Some may bring rice for their lunch, they will share their lunch with friends who do not have anything to eat at all.



- Where does our food come from?
- What would we do if we did not have any money to buy food?
- What would we do if we did not have any land to grow crops or money to buy seeds?
- Why is it important to have a nutritious meal every day?

The Children at Hsa Mu Htaw School do not have enough money to buy food or to grow their own. They do not know where or when they will be able to get their next healthy meal. This means that they are not Food Secure.

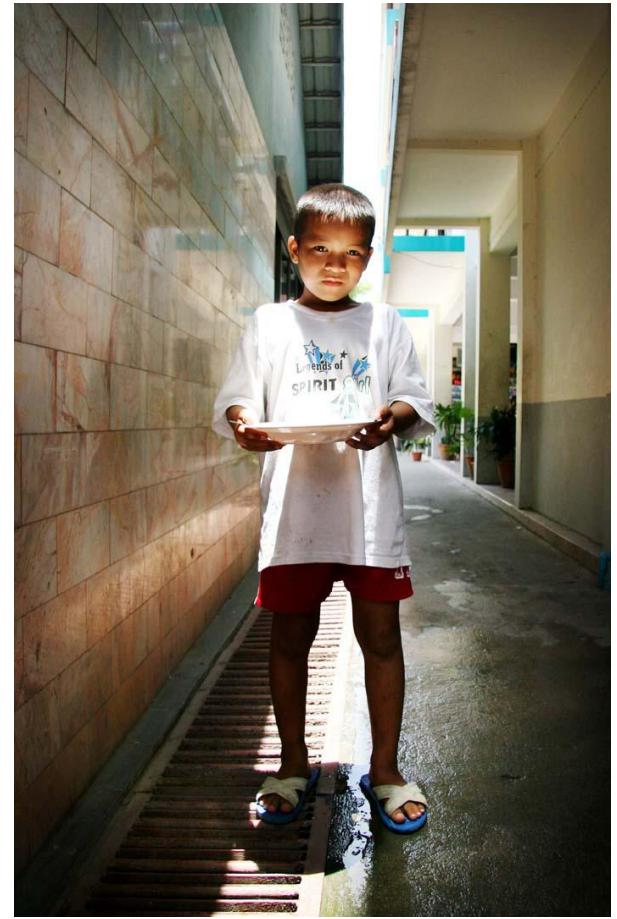

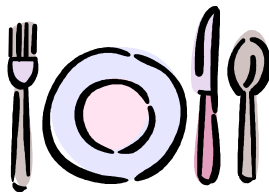

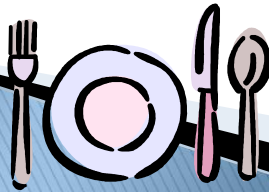
