A lasting contribution which will continue to make a difference long after your lifetime ...



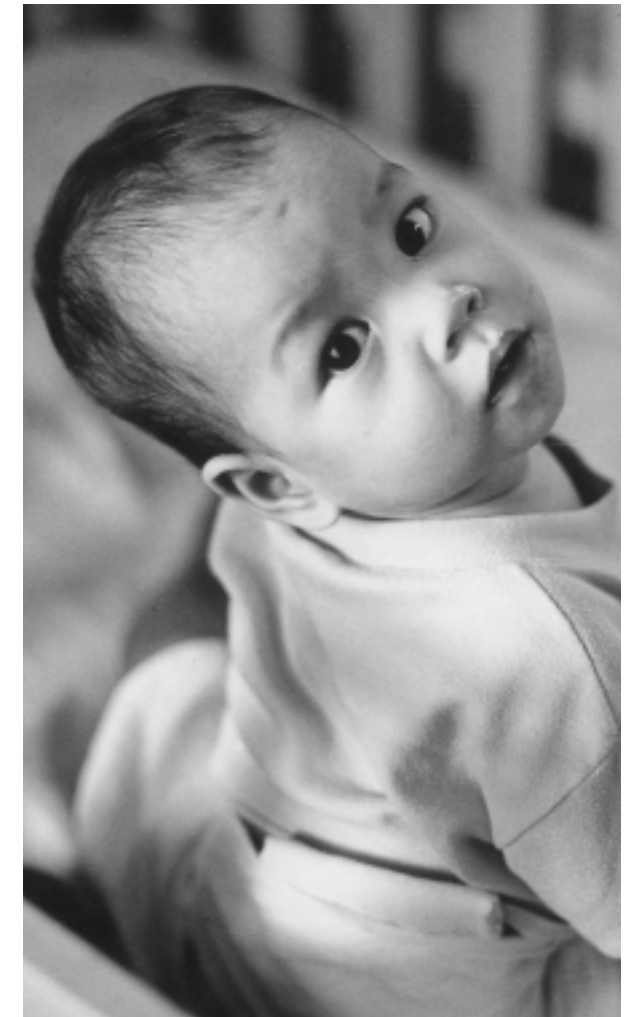

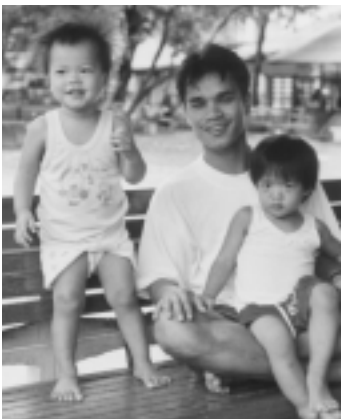


The Pattaya Orphanage provides a caring home and education for orphans, street children, blind and deaf children and disabled young people otherwise at risk of sexual exploitation, child labour or a life of poverty and begging.

Thanks to our dedicated staff rejected children develop a sense of self-esteem and turn into independent adults able to take their place in the world with confidence. 18 residents of the orphanage are currently studying at university following in the steps of quite a few others before them. And hopefully, inspiring the younger ones for the years to come!

Ratchanee was born in North-East Thailand. He was brought to the orphanage in 1982 when his step-mother died. By 1993, he

entered the Business Administration college at Bangkok University and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in 1996. He left the orphanage to take up employment but returns on week-ends and holidays to keep in touch with his many friends and to play with his younger 'brothers and sisters'. He now hopes to start a family of his own.



Remembering the Pattaya Orphanage Trust in your Will is your chance to give abandoned and disabled children in Thailand a new start in life and a brighter future.

- **£3,500 would pay for the 2 year computer studies of 1 disabled student and would help them find a job.**
- **£9,000 could provide our 50 orphaned babies with enough milk for a whole year.**
- **£23,400 can pay for 7 staff at the Street Children Centre for one year and could rescue more children from the dangers of living on the street.**
- **£96,000 would pay for 100 orphans to attend school for 10 years.**

A Gift in your Will is a special way of helping these children and young people, allowing us to plan ahead with greater confidence and making sure they can study for as long as they need.

Young people disabled by blindness, deafness, illness or accident are also welcomed into the Pattaya Orphanage family where specialist training helps equip each one to live a fulfilled and independent life.

Your legacy would touch many lives. Each year, the Pattaya Orphanage provides for 180 orphans, up to 100 street children, 220 deaf and blind children and 190 disabled young people.

A Service is held in the Pattaya Orphanage Chapel each year at which those who have left bequests to the Pattaya Orphanage Trust are remembered with thanks.

Pay less tax...

If you seek advice from your solicitor, you may find that by including a charity in your Will it is possible to reduce the amount of inheritance tax which your beneficiaries would have to pay. In addition, you will find that a residuary legacy is the most effective way of supporting our work while ensuring your family is still provided for. When your estate is distributed, all taxes and debts are paid first. Then specific and pecuniary legacies are made. Everything left after this is known as the residue of your estate.

If you choose to leave a Residuary Legacy to the Pattaya Orphanage Trust, please ask your solicitor to use the following wording:

'I GIVE all (or a share of) the residue of my estate to Pattaya Orphanage Trust, 124 North End House, Fitzjames Avenue, London W14 0RZ, Registered Charity Number 1085407 for its general charitable purposes absolutely, and the receipt of the Chief Executive or other proper officer of Pattaya Orphanage Trust shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors.'

It would be a great help to our future planning if you could let us know your intentions by returning to us the Pledge Form on the reverse. Please note that this pledge is simply a statement of your present intentions and is in no way legally binding.
